- The Spanish railway infrastructure manager has awarded the company the contract for the maintenance and support of the systems and equipment that operate at the Traffic Regulation Centers, via which the rail traffic on the network is controlled remotely and in real time
- The technology, developed by Indra in partnership with Adif, optimizes operations, improves network efficiency, increases the available capacity, and reinforces the highest degrees of safety and reliability
- The project will reaffirm Indra's standing as a technological partner for critical rail operating systems, an area in which the company boasts some of the leading international use cases in countries such as Lithuania, Estonia, and Saudi Arabia

Madrid, September 7, 2026. – Indra has been awarded a contract by Adif, the Spanish railway infrastructure management firm, to carry out the maintenance and support of the systems and equipment that operate at the Traffic Regulation Centers, via which the entire high-speed network is controlled remotely and in real time. The contract, worth 32.7 million euros and set to last four years, will guarantee the continuity of the large-scale and highly complex technical work required to ensure the maximum operability and reliability of this advanced technology, which is critical for rail transport.

The project encompasses the preventive and scheduled maintenance and renewal of the systems and equipment, as well as the corrective maintenance and the handling of potential incidents at the facilities of the Traffic Regulation Centers in Madrid (Atocha, Delicias and Villaverde), Antequera, Albacete, and Zaragoza.

The high-tech equipment and systems at these centers include the Centralized Traffic Control (CTC) and Da Vinci system, developed by Indra in partnership with Adif, which manages the Spanish high-speed rail network. These enable optimized operations, improved network efficiency, increased available capacity, and reinforcement of the highest levels of safety and reliability.

This new project will enhance Indra's position as a technological partner for railway operations using key high-speed systems, as well as their maintenance and upgrading.

"This new project reflects Indra's ability to act as a technological partner for the development and maintenance of highly critical systems. Our technology is designed to help operate increasingly complex transport networks in an efficient, safe, and automated manner, helping to redefine the future of railway management," declared José Benito García Cuéllar, director of Rail & Transit Spain for Indra.

Among its main benefits, it helps optimize the use of rail capacity, improves operational efficiency, reduces operating costs, and reinforces traffic safety.
